What is FinTech?

10 Days Learning Outcomes

Financial Technology

Participants will receive an overview of the development of Financial Technology. They will briefly explore well-known FinTech systems utilized by ecommerce companies. They will also explore how and why China has leapfrogged the West moving from a cash economy directly to a mobile payment platform.

Hands-on projects will include the investigation of FinTech disruptions and its contribution to reshaping commerce, investments, insurance, and securities; as well as its influence in the creation of crypto currencies such as Bitcoin and Blockchain.

The Market Economy

Participants will explore different Market Economy Models and demonstrate why nations that created a national debt survived and prospered economically.

The USA Federal Reserve & Currency

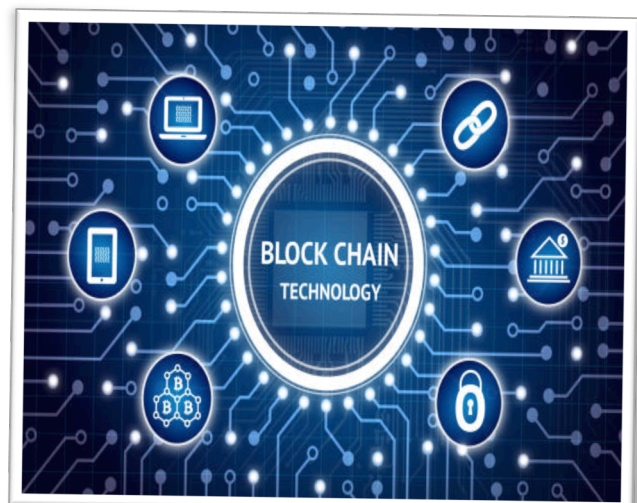
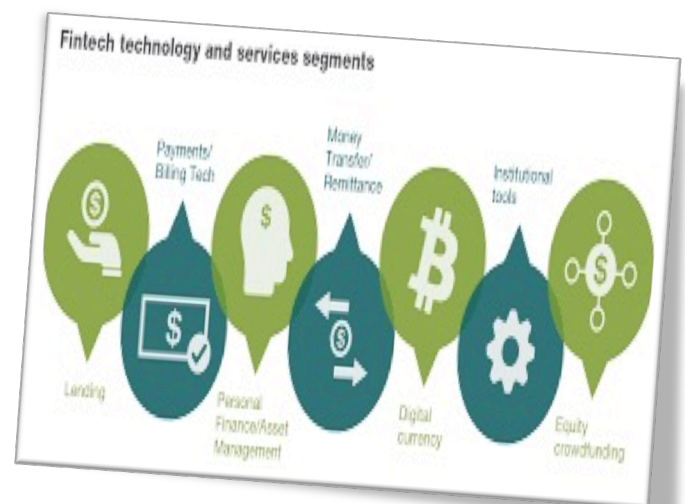
Participants will explain the pros and cons of the USA Federal Reserve System and present their findings of whether minting metal currencies contributed to state and local banks stability or instability.

Cyber Threats to FinTech

Participants will explore the various hacking and other threats to crypto currency and all aspects of FinTech. They will be able to present suggestions for banks and consumers to implement as protection of their finances and investments.

Group Projects Presentation

Participants will present their findings on a designated FinTech research topic.



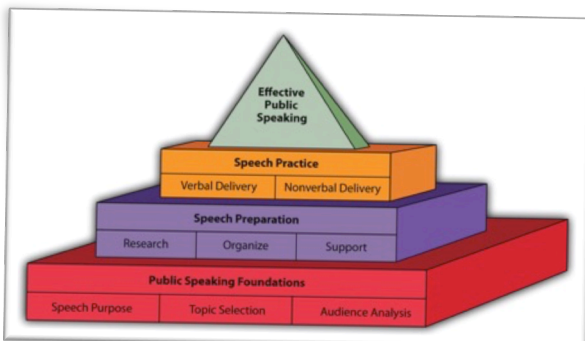


NorthStar Aerospace

Participants will be hosted on an exclusive private tour of NorthStar Aerospace where pilots from around the globe train for their pilots' licenses. NorthStar Aerospace is also the designated location where private corporations will launch their first commercial human space flights.

Innovations & Entrepreneurship

During the evenings of the Ten-day Academy, participants will formulate innovations and develop solutions by creating real time implementable programs or services, based on a specific challenge identified by a local corporation. They will differentiate their programs from solutions of their competitors, create metrics to measure the benefits of their ideas, and they will identify risks and ways to avoid or overcome those risks. Participants will present their final solutions, programs, or creations to the corporations for achievement awards.



Intensive Oral English – Oratory Skills

This class is a practical course designed to offer the novice speaker a number of opportunities to organize and prepare public speaking assignments. Participants will be able to stand in front of a live audience and present his/her practiced speech with proper delivery styles, gestures, and organized techniques.

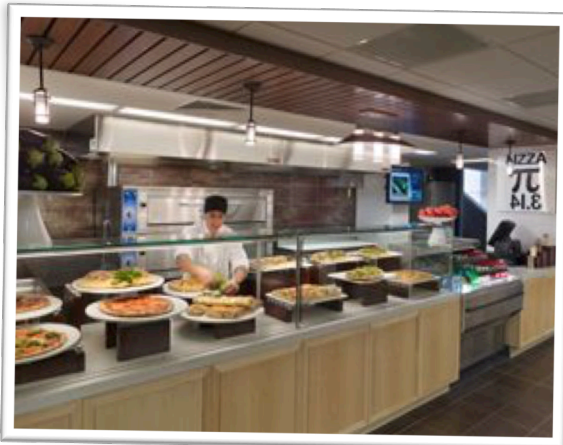
