



Gifted & Talented Institute Students and Parents Academy

Students attending the 3rd to 12th grades (3rd – 5th , 6th – 9th, & 10th – 12th) and one parent may apply for the Gifted & Talented Institute held at Rutgers University in New Jersey, USA.

Students will attend full day STEAM Classes specifically designed for Gifted students. Students are expected to fully participate and complete all assigned projects and activities.

Students will be given four formal Assessments: English, Achievement, Ability, and Personality Dimension.

Students will participate in a projects presentation to an audience of their peers and their parents.

One parent will attend the institute with one student.

Parents will attend 3 full lectures conducted by Dr. Elissa Brown, Leading Scholar in Gifted and Talented Education.

Parents will attend private meetings with a Professor/School Psychologist to discuss the outcomes of the student's 3 Assessments. During this private meeting, parents will be given diagnostic recommendations based on the tests scores.

Parents will also be given the opportunity to create and IEP – Individual Education Plan with the Professor for the student.
